

OCEANSIDE INVITES YOU TO PAINT A PARKING SPOT ON OCTOBER 17TH TO CELEBRATE YOUR SENIOR YEAR!

IMPORTANT: To paint a parking spot, students must turn in the attached form and have a valid OCA parking registration.

- Pay \$10 fee (non-fundable)
- Turn in the completed painting approval form and sketch
- Seniors Only
- Pizza provided

Rules:

1. Students will submit their drawn proposal of the parking space designs (including colors) to the front office by 10/13/22 for approval
2. You are required to purchase all of your supplies and all paint must meet requirements
3. The following will be prohibited for the designs (Keep it Classy!):
 - a. No offensive language, pictures or symbols.
 - b. No negative or rude language.
 - c. No “gang-style” tagging.
 - d. Nothing political. No guns. No drugs. No alcohol
4. Once a spot has been assigned/selected, no spot will be traded or switched among students.
5. Students must use a **water-based latex exterior paint**. Students must purchase their own paint and supplies - this includes bowls and brushes.
 - a. Students will not use “Striping Paint” or any other “Raised” paint or Roofing Tar.
 - b. NO spray paint, glitter, or textured paint.
 - c. Students will not cover white painted parking lines.
 - d. Students must get their paint checked by OCA administration before beginning.

Items: Approved paint, broom to sweep off parking spot prior to painting, paint brushes/rollers/sponge, painters’ tape/stencils, water bucket for dirty brushes, tray(s) for paint, chalk to sketch out design, towels/blankets to sit on, lawn chairs, pop-up tents for shade, sunscreen, trash bags, paper towels, water to drink

- **Any Oceanside student who paints a parking spot without permission or vandalizes a senior parking spot will lose parking privileges and face disciplinary action and consequences.**
- **Even though you are painting a spot it is not your assigned space, no guarantee to park in that spot.**

Approval Form: Sketch of Parking Spot. You must be detailed and show or list colors, all words, and all drawings. You must leave four inches around the entire perimeter of the parking spot including the top and bottom of the parking spot. Turn this page in to the front office when you purchase your parking spot with \$10 fee in addition to parking permit application and fee. We will approve and give to Mrs. Peirano for you to have when painting.
