



WIN Test Day Information!

Date: Thursday, October 29, 2020

Audience: 12th grade (**mandatory**)

Time: 7:30AM at OCA (for both AM & PM students)

What is the WIN TEST?

- The *mandatory* WIN test assesses your career readiness skills and consists of four (4) different sections which will take approximately 60 minutes each.
- This state mandated test (typically taken Spring of junior year) was re-scheduled for this Fall due to school closures.
- Compared to the ACT and SAT this test will be MUCH easier!
- Based on your scores you will receive a certificate indicating your level of Career Readiness (think resume and job interviews)!

On Test Day:

- Report to your testing room by 7:25AM with:
 - Two (2) #2 pencils
 - An approved calculator
 - All TI-83 and TI-84, TI-Nspire, TI-Nspire CX, TI-Nspire with touchpad, Casio FX-9750GII, Casio FX9860GII(S), Casio CG10PRISM, and any basic four function calculators are acceptable.
- Leave electronic devices and equipment (phones, laptops, cameras, wearable technology, etc.) AT HOME!
 - Students will not have access to cell phones or electronic devices at ANY time during the testing period (including breaks).
- Students will be dismissed from school after the test is over (approx. 12:15PM).

Helpful hints if you are testing:

- Try your BEST on the TEST!
- Our school results will be compared to other schools in the area and be part of our State School Report Card...so take the opportunity to represent our Landshark Community well!

The WIN test will be administered on-campus.
Students should not arrive earlier than 7:20AM.
