



SAT Test Day Information!

Date: Wednesday, March 25, 2020

Audience: 11th grade (third year **pre-registered** students)

Time: 7:30AM at OCA (for both AM & PM students- *arrive by 7:25 AM*)

This will be a Dual Enrollment and On-Campus Virtual class *personalized learning* day. High School classes will run as regularly scheduled and attendance is expected for all those not testing.

MANDATORY Pre-Test Session (for pre-registered students)

- AM Students - Weds. March 18, 2020 in room 115 @ 11:25AM.
- PM Students- March 19, 2020 in room 117 @ 10:25AM.

On Test Day:

- Report to your testing room by 7:25AM with:
 - PHOTO ID
 - Two (2) #2 pencils
 - An approved calculator (information on approved calculators can be found at <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat/taking-the-test/calculator-policy>)
- *Testing room assignments to be distributed at Pre-Test Session!* Students must attend the pre-test session in order to be admitted to their testing room on March 25th!
- Leave electronic devices and equipment (phones, laptops, cameras, wearable technology, etc.) **AT HOME!**
 - Students will not have access to cell phones or electronic devices at ANY time during the testing period (including breaks).
- Snacks: You may bring water and a snack into the testing room to be placed under the desk. Snacks *may only* be eaten during provided breaks and outside the classroom.
- Students will be dismissed from school after the *SAT with writing test* is over (approx. 12:15PM)
